Brief History

The Walk of Fame was established at the Dayton International Airport in 1996 by Celebration Dayton '96, in recognition of our city's bicentennial. The 2003 Committee that eventually became known as 'Inventing Flight,' assumed the program in 1997 with the intention to continue it only through the year 2003. Then in 2003, Wright Dunbar, Inc. assumed responsibility for continuation of the program and installed the Walk of Fame in the sidewalks of the Wright Dunbar Business District.

Purpose of the Walk of Fame

The purpose is to recognize and celebrate the lives and accomplishments of individuals or groups from the Dayton Region who have made an enduring impact locally, regionally, nationally, or internationally. Individual granite pavers will include name(s), dates, and a brief description of the contributions. The induction ceremony will occur in the fall each year.

Nomination Criteria

Nominees, living or deceased, must have made outstanding contributions more than five years ago from the date of this application, in one or more of the following areas:

Aviation	Government/Military	Science

Community Service	Law	Sports
Education	Medicine	Other

Nominees must be individuals or groups from the Dayton Region or individuals or groups who have spent a significant amount of time in the Dayton Region.

The Judging Committee will make final selections based on how the nominee's accomplishments have made an enduring impact on our local community, our region, the nation and/or the world.

Nominations for the current year **must** be received by Wright Dunbar, Inc. no later than the close of business on Thursday, March 29, 2012.

Nominations will be considered active for three (3) years from the date of submission after which a new nominating form must be submitted. The Judging Committee recommends updating **active** nominations when additional information is available.

The *Walk of Fame Press and Community Announcement Event* will be held in the Wright Dunbar Business District on Wednesday Evening September 19th at 5:00 pm. Call for information.

A ticketed *Walk of Fame Affair* will be held on September 20th to celebrate this year's inductees. Call for information.
